Guidelines for Mr. Benson's
name:
Honors Earth Science Class

1. Late work will be accepted up to 3 school days beyond the due date for $30 \%$ off. Assignments are "late" if they are not turned in at the start of class (SOC) on the due date. IMPORTANT: If you are going to be gone for sports or other activities, get your assignments in BEFORE you leave. If wait until you get back, they will be considered "late".
2. If you are going to miss classes for activities, appointments, etc., make arrangements to attend one of Benson's other classes (IF POSSIBLE - if you have a study hall). Benson has classes during periods $1,3,4,5$, and 7 .
3. You should have a notebook to take notes in, and a folder to keep handouts in.
4. There will be one test per month (100 points each). It is important to study all of the notes, handouts, labs, MESPOWs, and worksheets, etc. that were done during that unit.

It is much more important that you listen and think during class. Do not expect to do well on tests if you have simply taken notes and studied them (without listening and thinking in class).
5. If you've been absent, ask Mr. Benson what you've missed AND check his calendar at bengalfrosh.com.
6. DO NOT copy answers from anyone. DO NOT lend your work to someone so they can copy. This is not "helping", "sharing", or "working together" it is CHEATING!
7. If you score below $70 \%$ on a test, you will have one week to "fix" the test on your own time (not in study hall). You can earn up to half of the points back by using your notebook and handouts to make corrections, raising the score up to a maximum of 70\%. You may come in before school (7:40 to $8: 10$ ), after school ( $3: 15$ ), or during lunch.
8. There will be "Montana Earth Science Pictures of the Week" (MESPOWs) assigned almost every week. Each Monday, Benson will assign pictures from www.formontana.net. You should carefully read all of the MESPOWs assigned for that week and then choose one to do with the worksheet. The worksheet can be picked up in the classroom or downloaded from the web site. They are due at the start of class every Friday.
9. The grading scale is as follows: $90-100 \%$ : A $80-89 \%$ : B $70-79 \%$ : C $60-69 \%$ : D
10. Your semester grade will be determined this way . .

1st quarter grade: 40\% 2nd quarter grade: 40\% semester test: 20\%
11. If you need help or don't understand something, please ask Mr. Benson. From 7:40 am to 8:15 am is the best time to come in and get extra help and $3: 10 \mathrm{pm}$ to $3: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ is another good time.
