Guidelines for Mr. Benson's Earth Science Classes

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- 1. **Late work** will be accepted up to 3 class days beyond the due date for 30% off. Assignments are "late" if they are not turned in at the **start** of class (SOC) on the due date.
- 3. You should have a notebook to take notes in and a folder to keep handouts in. Both should contain only Earth Science materials (no other classes).
- 4. There will be one test every month (100 points each). **It is important to study** all of the handouts, labs, and worksheets, etc. that were done during that unit.

NOTE: It is much more important that you listen and think during class. Do not expect to do well on tests if you have simply taken notes and studied them (without listening <u>and</u> thinking in class).

- 5. If you've been absent, ask Mr. Benson what you missed and check his calendar at **bengalfrosh.com**.
- 6. DO NOT copy answers from anyone. DO NOT "share" your work with someone so they can copy. This is CHEATING!
- 7. After a unit test has been corrected, you have a week to "fix" your test on your own time (not in study hall). You may earn up to half of the points back by using your notebook and/or handouts to find correct answers. You can come in before school (7:40 to 8:10), after school (3:10 to 3:30), or during lunch to make corrections.
- 8. If you are absent when a test is given, you have one week to make it up. It is your responsibility to make arrangements with Mr. Benson.
- 9. The **grading scale** is as follows: 90-100%: A 80-89%: B 70-79%: C 60-69%: D
- 10. Your **semester grade** will be determined this way:

1st quarter grade: 40% 2nd quarter grade: 40% semester test: 20%

11. **If you need help** or don't understand something, please ask Mr. Benson. From 7:40 am to 8:15 am is the best time to come in for help. Right after school (3:15 pm) is another good time.
